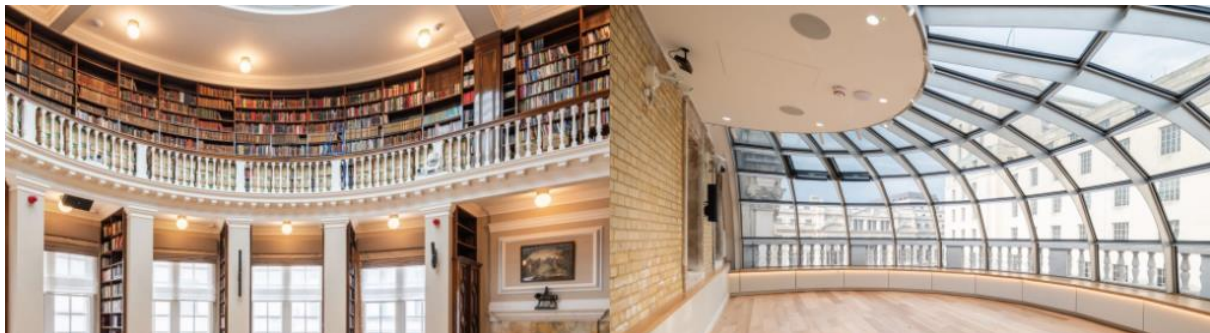


61 Whitehall RUSI / Coniston



The long-term home of the Royal United Services Institute (RUSI) since 1895, 61 Whitehall underwent a complete refurbishment to meet its more modern operational requirements.

A Grade II listed building, it required a refresh to the flooring, library area and function rooms, plus the creation of a south facing dome that will be used for a variety of different events, study pods and a high quality media room overlooking the main Duke of Wellington Hall – this was a real challenge in terms of the acoustic demands being set, and is why we are so proud of the results.

From initial Noise Impact Assessment, planning and survey works, CSA collaborated with the Design Team and the Contractor throughout, advising on acoustic aspects and detailing - from MEP services, installation of new floors and partitions, through to selection and location of architectural finishes - to maximise the acoustic properties of the spaces within the constraints of the building's listed status.

The renovation prioritises energy efficiency with air source heat pumps, LED lighting and natural ventilation where possible, making this a model for sustainable design.
